5EB will be visiting Skelton Grange on: Tuesday 16th July 2024.

Our trip to Skelton Grange offers a dynamic hands-on experience for students to deepen their understanding of life cycles in nature, aligning closely with their science curriculum. Throughout the excursion, children engage with various environments and habitats, immersing themselves in the natural world. Guided by knowledgeable instructors, they explore the intricate life cycles of plants, animals, and insects. Through outdoor activities and observations, students apply their classroom learning in a practical setting, fostering a deeper appreciation for the wonders of the natural world.

We will be leaving school by Mini Bus at 9:30am so it is especially important that all children are in school on time. We will arrive back at approximately 2:45pm. The arrival time back in school is dependent on traffic, but school will send an update via text if there are any delays. All pupils will be required to bring a packed lunch on the day of their trip.

If your child is entitled to Free School Meals, the office will send out further communication via text nearer to the trip date to confirm if a meal is required.

To make these amazing experiences happen, we really need your support. We are asking for a £15 voluntary contribution from each child to help us fund the visit. The Governing Body of Beeston Primary School want as many children in school as possible to have the chance to take part in experiences like these. To make that happen, they have agreed that school will contribute towards the costs. These experiences cannot happen without the support of our families also helping towards the cost and in cases where we do not receive sufficient contributions; we will have to cancel the trip. Payment for the trip can be made using our online payment system SchoolMoney; contributions can also be made via instalment amounts upon request via the office. When making payment, please also tick the 'parental consent' box in order to give permission for your child to attend. If you are unable to pay, you must contact the school office by Wednesday 3rd July 2024.

Please note: Unfortunately, we are unable to consider refunds for non-attendance as the school is committed to non-refundable deposits and payments at the time of booking trips and educational visits.

Important Information:

- Your child will not be able to attend the trip if you have not ticked the 'parental consent' box on SchoolMoney.
- Your child's current medical conditions and dietary/medical information will be taken from school records. If there are any changes to your child's details, <u>as a matter of urgency</u>, you must call or email the school office to update.
- If there are any changes to your child's emergency contact details from the information that you have provided school with previously, you must call or email the school office to advise accordingly.

If your child is entitled to Free School Meals, the office will send out further communication via text nearer to the trip date to confirm if a meal is required.
