WHAT ROLES ARE AVAILABLE?

Chair – Leads the committee and ensures the constitution is followed. Facilitates meetings; sets dates and agendas for meetings; delegates tasks; liaises with school; welcomes and motivates new members; ensures the PTA is registered with the correct regulatory bodies (such as the charity commission); is signatory on the bank account.

Treasurer – Controls the PTA's funds.

We do already have an excellent treasurer in place, who is happy to continue in the role and is an experienced accountant, working in the charity sector. She has experience of the PTA and its workings, so is a valuable member of the team. However, she is also happy to stand down and provide support if a new candidate steps forward.

Secretary – Helps ensure the PTA activities run smoothly. Takes minutes at meetings, recording actions points, keeps records, helps with communications.

General Volunteers – Help when they can. Attend meetings, participate in discussions, make suggestions, support the committee members.

There are options to vote in a vice-chair (to assist the chair) and committee members; the more people in official roles, means the quorum required to make decisions is higher, so this needs to be considered.

New committee members need to be voted in by the correct number of people for it to be officially valid and this will take place at a meeting held in school - look out for a text detailing to date this is taking place.
